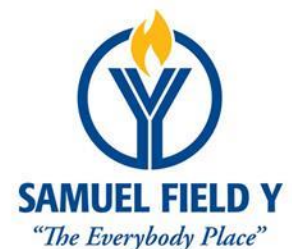

Please note that the pool areas must be vacated 30 minutes prior to closing time.
Hours of closing are subject to change at the discretion of Management.

THURSDAY LATE NIGHT SPECIAL: Our facility will remain open until 9:30PM during July & August.

- **Adult and Child guests will be \$10 after 5:00 PM.**
- Members of the Tanenbaum Family Pool will be allowed to use the Bay Terrace Pool & Terrace Center on all late nights after 5:00 PM. All rules and regulations must be followed in accordance with the terms and agreements of membership.

GUEST PASSES: Guest Passes are sold in our main office at the discretion of the Center. Guests will be admitted only upon presentation of a guest pass and **must be accompanied by a member. Anyone under the age of 18 cannot purchase a pass for an individual under the age of 18.** While at the center, guests are required to follow all the center rules and regulations. **There will be no refunds for guest passes at any time.**

LOCKERS: Reserved seasonal lockers are available to all adult members for a minimal fee. All remaining unreserved and available lockers may be used by members for daily use only. No lock may be left on an unreserved locker overnight. Management reserves the right to remove any locks which are in violation. All lockers must be cleaned out, and locks removed on or before the last day of the season.

DECK FURNITURE: Storage racks may be rented for the season at a fee of \$20.00 per rack. A maximum of two racks (one item per rack space) may be rented per family, subject to availability. Only one chaise lounge and/or one deck chair per family may be utilized. Chaise lounges and deck chairs must be brought into the Center by June 15th, and are not to leave the Center during the rental season. Dimensions of chaise lounges are as follows: W 8" x H 25" x L 31". **The Center is not responsible for chaise lounges and deck chairs stored in racks.**

REFUND POLICY ON MEMBERSHIP: Refunds are made only under the following instances:

In the event a Center member requests a cancellation of their membership, a written letter must be provided. Membership fees are non-transferable. Full refunds are available until Friday, May 26th, 2017, and a 50% refund prior to Monday, June 5th, 2017. **There will be no refunds after Monday, June 5th, 2017.**

- There is a \$75.00 administrative fee for any and all requested refunds.

SMOKING POLICY: This facility is a smoke-free environment. Any member found smoking will be subject to suspension from the Center.

INCLEMENT WEATHER CLOSINGS: Management reserves the right to close the facility, on days of inclement weather or for any other necessary reason, regarding the best interests of the Center. Please call ahead to confirm time of closing.

Payment shall be made by cash, check, money order, or credit card. Our facility accepts Visa, MasterCard, American Express, and Discover. Checks or money order for the summer season should be made payable to the Samuel Field Y.

TERMS OF MEMBERSHIP:

The following are the Rules and Regulations of the Tanenbaum Family Pool at the Samuel Field Y, which members agree to abide by in the membership application. Your cooperation with these rules is an important factor in assuring your safe enjoyment of the Center.

1. The Center and its management assume no responsibility whatsoever for personal injury of any kind resulting directly or indirectly from the use of the facility, or any equipment belonging to it. The Center will not be responsible for the loss or damage of any property belonging to a member, guest, or visitor.
2. The Center reserves the right to revoke the membership of any member who commences legal proceedings against the Center. If the Center commences legal proceedings against a member, the Center has the right to revoke membership.
3. The Center reserves the right to revoke the membership of any member whose conduct is deemed undesirable.
4. No person, whose Center membership has been denied or cancelled by management, will be admitted as a guest.
5. No person will be allowed into the Center without presentation of a member pass or guest pass. All members must enter the Center through the designated entrances.
6. Membership passes are non-transferable. Any membership application found to contain false information will result in the immediate cancellation of the entire family's membership.
7. Guest Passes are sold in our main office at the discretion of the Center. Guests will be admitted only upon presentation of a guest pass and **must be accompanied by a member. Anyone under the age of 18 cannot purchase a pass for an individual under the age of 18.** While at the center, guests are required to follow all the center rules and regulations. **There will be no refunds of guest passes at any time.**
8. There shall be no reservations of chairs or tables. Tables are to be utilized for activity by any member, and not for storage of personal items. Any member may utilize tables not being used for activity. Center tables or umbrellas may not be moved from designated locations.
9. This facility is a smoke-free environment. Any member found smoking will be subject to suspension from the Center.
10. The bringing of food, beverages, or liquor into any part of the Center is **prohibited** at all times. **The management reserves the right to inspect bags for these items.** Clear bottled water is an exception to this rule, for all members, guests and staff. _____ *(please initial)*
11. Food purchased in the cafeteria should be eaten in designated areas only. **Reminder: No food, paper or plastic cups or beverages (except clear bottled water) is permitted on the upper deck.** Members violating these rules are subject to suspension from the Center.
12. No soliciting of any kind is permitted on the premises without express written permission of the Center's management.
13. Strollers and carriage are permitted on the upper deck. Playpens are not allowed on the premises. Carriages and strollers must be taken home at the end of the day, and cannot be stored on the premises.
14. Management reserves the right to close the Center at any time, due to inclement weather, or for any other necessary reason that is in the best interest of the Center. Please call ahead on these days to confirm time of closing.
15. Lockers not rented for the season may be used on a first come, first serve daily basis. Members using lockers for the day must remove the lock and contents by the close of the day, or these locks will be cut and their contents removed. The Center is not responsible for locks and contents left at the end of the day. All lockers must be cleaned out, and locks removed on or before the last day of the season.
16. Members must provide their own locks for their lockers and lounge racks. One lounge chair per rack. Lounge chairs will be removed from any unassigned racks.
17. Use of the Center before or after operating hours is prohibited. **Violators will be prosecuted.**
18. Warnings by management and/or lifeguards as to reckless behavior, or diving risks in the pools must be observed. No person may enter the pools or deck area unless a lifeguard is on duty. No running or horseplay allowed in the pool or pool area. Failure to observe these rules will result in expulsion from the pool and/or premises. Management reserves the right to allow or restrict devices, as well as the times in which they are permitted.
19. Floats will be limited, in size, at the discretion of management during float time.
20. **Parents shall be responsible for their children's conduct and safety throughout the Center, and must provide supervision for their children in all pools.**
21. **Infants and children not toilet trained must wear a swim diaper and a bathing suit, or a diaper, rubber pants, and a bathing suit in order to enter the pool.** Children under the age of three (3) will be allowed in the upper deck pool only when accompanied, **at all times**, by an adult. Children over the age of eight (8) are not permitted in the kiddie pool.
22. Lounges are not permitted under any canopy area. **Lounges and deck chairs must remain in the Center for the duration of the summer season. They may not be taken in or out of the Center on a daily basis. They must be removed on or before the last day of the season only.**
23. Ball playing is only allowed in the recreation area. Sneakers must be worn on all courts, at all times.
24. Chairs or any other equipment is not allowed within the lines surrounding the pools.
25. All persons are required to shower, remove suntan oil, and use the lavatory before entering the pool. No expectorating or blowing noses in the pool. No one shall be permitted to use the pool with bandages, skin diseases, colds, or coughs.
26. The wearing of colored shirts, underwear, and cut-off jeans is not permitted in the pool. All members and guests are required to be in proper pool attire when making use of the Center, cafeteria, or interior portions of the facility. No topless bathing allowed. Rubber swim shoes are permitted to be worn in the pool.
27. Only one person is allowed on the diving board at any one time. No one shall dive until the previous diver has cleared the diving area.
28. Personal radios, tape recorders, camera phones, TVs, etc., are limited to the use of headphones, as a courtesy to fellow Center members.
29. Dogs, cats, or pets of any kind are not permitted on the premises.
30. The Center will provide a copy of the above "Rules & Regulations" to a member upon request.
31. These "Rules & Regulations" are subject to change without prior notice at the discretion of the management. Any additional "Rules & Regulations" will be posted at the center.
32. The center reserves the right to make any additional rules it deems necessary to promote the welfare and safety of the members and the center.
